Plant Report- Peter Kavalus Applied Water Management

All plants are in compliance. A full monthly report for October and November have been included in the member's packets. There were no questions from the board, Due to new state regulations requiring laboratory certifications, they have requested that Stage V be under a separate lab number.

Phosphorous studies continue at both Stage I/II and Stage V with Stage I/II ending soon.

Inspections were completed by the NJDEP and there were no issues.

Stage V Lab Certification had passed proficiency test.

The paving of the access road at the Stage V plant has been completed.

Engineers Report- James Wancho PE PS & S

A full complete engineer report is included in the packets tonight for the members review. Contracts 52 and 53 are ongoing with the design completed. The upgrading at Stage IV UV disinfection system was included in the Capital improvements list for 2013 and originally proposed to be funded under a new bond issue. This has been included in the Contract #52 under the NJEIFP loan application and plans and specifications for Contract 52. This is to be entirely funded under this new loan. Mr. Wancho has responded to the DEP on the specifications on these projects.

PS & S is working on an I and I study in the Stage I/II area identifying areas which may need remediation and repairs.

Mr. Wancho was asked to project future projects for the range of 3-5 years. This will be done and reported back to Mr. Ferraioli and Mr. Mosquera as directed.

This is an application for a single connection for the expansion of the existing building. This applicant will be using this as a dental office and will be assessed two EDUS in the Middlebrooks sewer service area.

Mr. Goodsell spoke on the Public Attorney Report which was included in the member's packets. Action to be taken tonight for Item C: 2015 Energy Supplier. As you recall the term for the 2013 online action to procure a third party energy supplier is almost to the end of termination. The Authority has seen a substantial savings by using a third party and again the board is being asked for their comments and approval to seek another third party supplier.

After receiving approval from the Authority, EMEX will schedule the reverse action. A trigger resolution is included in tonight s packet to award a contract after the action closes if the bids are below a threshold amount.

Also to note the rate hearing has been scheduled December 29 at 10AM. This had been rescheduled due to timing and not having the rates in preparation for the December 10 meeting.
