RESOLUTION NO. 12-146

RESOLUTION APPROVING COST SUBSTANTIATION CERTIFICATE #310 SUBMITTED BY THE OPERATOR OF THE AUTHORITY'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM, APPLIED WATER MANAGEMENT, INC., FOR PAYMENT OF CERTAIN EXPENSES RELATED TO THE CONTROL PANEL MODIFICATION AT THE DOGWOOD PUMP STATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Applied Water Management, Inc. ("AWM") operates the Authority's Wastewater Treatment System pursuant to the Wastewater Treatment System Operation and Maintenance Agreement between Warren Township Sewerage Authority and AWM, dated June 1, 2009 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that AWM submit a Cost Substantiation Certificate ("CSC") for any cost reasonably incurred or to be incurred by AWM which is chargeable in whole or in part to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 4.8 of the Agreement provides that AWM shall be responsible for the cost of Routine Maintenance and Preventive Maintenance of the Wastewater Treatment System, but that the Authority shall be responsible for the costs associated with repairs, replacements, and non-Routine Maintenance provided that AWM follows the Cost Substantiation procedures set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, it was discovered that the level controller was not able to pick up the signal from the transducer, therefore the pumps could not operate at the correct levels. During this time, the station operated on back up float control; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the control panel at the Dogwood Pump station had to be modified, which is an item of repair, replacement, or non-Routine Maintenance pursuant to Article IV and Appendix 16 of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, AWM utilized R&R Pump and Control Services, LLC to supply the parts and labor to perform the control panel modification, and R&R Pump and Control Services has submitted an invoice to AWM for services rendered in the amount of \$4,250.00; and

WHEREAS, AWM has submitted CSC #310 for the total cost for the control panel modification at the Dogwood Pump Station, based on the above-referenced invoice and the applicable ten (10%) percent markup to that invoice, for a total cost of \$4,675.00 to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, these items of work are not included on the pre-approved list submitted by AWM for this Contract Year, but the Authority agrees that this additional work is a necessary item of repair, replacement, or non-Routine Maintenance; and

WHEREAS, payment to AWM shall be from the Authority's Operating Account; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has reviewed CSC #310, dated December 13, 2012, in the amount of \$4,675.00, and is satisfied that the amount is fair and reasonable, and that the Authority desires to approve CSC #310.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Warren Township Sewerage Authority in the County of Somerset, New Jersey that:

1. CSC #310, signed in the amount of \$4,675.00, for payment of costs incurred from the repair and rebuild of the variable frequency drive at the Stage IV influent pump #1, be and hereby is approved.


