

**WARREN TOWNSHIP SEWERAGE AUTHORITY
RESOLUTION NO. 12 -38**

**RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 08-18 AND
REINSTATING RESOLUTION 06-104 WHICH GRANTED
PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION OF FRANK
SALVATO FOR A SEWER EXTENSION AND TWO (2) EDUS OF
CAPACITY TO SERVE TWO (2) SINGLE FAMILY DWELLINGS
IN THE PROPOSED SUBDIVISION OF LOT 6.01, BLOCK 32, 36
MT. HOREB ROAD IN THE MIDDLEBROOK SEWER SERVICE
AREA**

WHEREAS, the applicant, Frank Salvato, had applied to the Authority for preliminary approval for a 421 linear foot sanitary sewer extension and two (2) EDUs of capacity to serve a two lot subdivision at 36 Mt. Horeb Road, Block 32, Lot 6.01, in the Middlebrook sewer service area and by Resolution 06-104, dated August 16, 2006, the Authority granted such preliminary approval; and

WHEREAS, the applicant's escrow account, established in conjunction with the application and utilized for the costs of professional services incurred in connection with the application, was insufficiently funded, and the applicant owed \$1,314.21 for professional services rendered; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's attorney, by letter dated September 24, 2007, requested that the applicant deposit the required escrow fees, and by letter dated December 12, 2007, advised the applicant that if no deposit was received by January 15, 2008, the preliminary approval granted by Resolution 06-104 would be rescinded, all applicable agencies would be notified, and the Authority would take all available means to obtain payment; and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2008 the Authority adopted Resolution 08-18 which rescinded preliminary approval granted by Resolution 06-104; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2008, shortly after adoption of Resolution 08-18, the applicant, Frank Salvato, did pay the Authority the \$1,314.21 he owed; and

WHEREAS, despite payment of the required amount, the applicant failed to request reinstatement of the approval granted in Resolution 06-104, but had not intended to abandon the project, and a recent request was made to the Authority to confirm the continued applicability of Resolution 06-104.


