**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO APPLIED
WATER MANAGEMENT FOR COSTS INCURRED IN
CLEANING A GREASE BLOCKAGE AT THE
STONEHOUSE RESTAURANT**

WHEREAS, Applied Water Management, Inc. ("Applied") operates the Authority's Wastewater Treatment System pursuant to the Wastewater Treatment System Operation and Maintenance Agreement between Warren Township Sewerage Authority and Applied Water Management, Inc., commencing June 1, 2009 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Stonehouse Restaurant, located at 50 Stirling Road, experienced a complete backup of their sewer system on December 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Applied responded to this situation and was able to successfully remove the blockage by jetting the sewer line; and

WHEREAS, based on Applied's investigation, the backup was caused by a heavy grease buildup from the Stonehouse; and

WHEREAS, Applied submitted an invoice to the Authority for removal of the grease blockage at Stonehouse in the total amount of \$1,332.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority submitted a letter to Stonehouse advising that, as provided for in Section 9.4.1(d) of the Authority's Rules and Regulations, the Authority is empowered to obtain reimbursement for the costs incurred in having to clean the blockage to the sewer line caused by the grease buildup; and

WHEREAS, Stonehouse submitted a check in the amount of \$1,332.00 to the Authority for Applied's services in removing the blockage; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to reimburse Applied \$1,332.00 for the services performed in clearing the grease blockage at the Stonehouse Restaurant on December 31, 2011.


