RESOLUTION 15 - 04

A RESOLUTION AWARDDING CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

WHEREAS, there exists a need for professional engineering services for the Warren Township Sewerage Authority for the period from February 4, 2015 through January 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, such professional engineering services include, but are not limited to, engineering design, bid evaluation and construction management work for projects to be submitted for financing through the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust Program, as well as projects to be financed with the proceeds for Authority-issued bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) allows the award of contracts for "professional services" without competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law requires that any resolution authorizing an award for a professional services contract without competitive bidding be publicly advertised; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is desirous of awarding a professional services contract for engineering services to the current engineer, Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC and

WHEREAS, a New Jersey Business Registration Certificate is on file in the Authority office, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Warren Township Sewerage Authority, in the County of Somerset, New Jersey, on this 6th day of February, 2014, as follows:


1. The Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached agreement with James Warcho, P.E. of the engineering firm of Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC whose offices are located at 67 Mountain Blvd. Warren NJ 07059, on behalf of the Warren Township Sewerage Authority.
2. This contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "professional services" contract under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, as New Jersey Statute N.J.S.A.40A:11-1, (et. seq) permits such work to be performed without advertising for bids.
3. A copy of this resolution shall be published in the Echo Sentinel within ten (10) days of its passage in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law.
